## SPEED ART MUSEUM wHY ARCHITECTURE

Venosa proudly contributed to the expansion of the Speed Art Museum. Kulapat Yantrasast, Creative Director of wHY Architecture, designed the spaces with local firm K. Norman Berry Associates. Featured on this page is one of two terrazzo staircases, designed with open risers and glass rails, wrapping around the perimeter of the new threestory atrium. On the following page, the curved monumental staircase is a flourish of exquisite design in the heart of the renovated, original 1927 museum building. Its combination tread and risers fall over the edge into a radial terrazzo stringer with an elegant reveal. The project took three years to complete and added seventy-two thousand square feet. Hosting thousands of works of art, the Speed Art Museum is the oldest, and largest museum in the region, and a premiere cultural institution in Kentucky.

## COVERS: AMERICA PLACE JEFFERSONVILLE, INDIANA wHY ARCHITECTURE

America Place is more than an office building, it hosts an expansive, private contemporary art collection. The centerpiece of the design is a three-story, spiral, white terrazzo staircase that is enhanced by illuminated tread risers.
